**PROHIBITION FOR EXPORT OF HAZARDOUS WASTES AND OTHER WASTES TO THE
REPUBLIC OF MOZAMBIQUE**

Persuant to Article 4(1) of the Basel Convention, Republic of Mozambique had informed the Parties of the Basel Convention of its prohibition to the import of hazardous wastes and other wastes into the Republic of Mozambique. You may wish to refer to the Basel Convention website at <http://basel.int/natdef/frsetmain.php> for a list of countries that have banned the import of hazardous wastes.

2 Exporters are required to meet the requirements stipulated under the Basel Convention and the Hazardous Waste (Control of Export, Import and Transit) Act. You may wish to refer to NEA website at <http://app2.nea.gov.sg/baselcon.aspx> for more information on the Basel Convention and the said Act. Please note that approval to export hazardous waste shall only be granted on a case-by-case basis.

3 We would like to remind all traders, importers, exporters, freight forwarders, cargo agents and carriers to exercise due care not to export hazardous waste controlled under the Basel Convention unless you have obtained the relevant Basel permits issued by our Department.
