### CLEAN AND GREEN SINGAPORE AWARDS 2021

#### Introduction

The Clean & Green Singapore (CGS) Awards recognises grassroots organisations for their efforts in achieving environmental goals in the areas of public hygiene and cleanliness, energy efficiency and resource conservation. The qualifying period for the Awards is from 1 Apr 2020 to 31 Mar 2021. The recipients of the CGS Awards 2021 were selected by an Evaluation Panel chaired by Mr Desmond Tan, Minister of State, Ministry of Sustainability and the Environment. A total of 195 awards are being presented this year. 16 national level awards were presented by the Guest of Honour, Deputy Prime Minister and Coordinating Minister for Economic Policies, Heng Swee Keat, at the Clean and Green Singapore (CGS) Launch Event on 21 November 2021 at Kampong Admiralty. District-level and Best Cleaners awards will be presented at District environmental events scheduled in 2022.

169 cleaners will be receiving the CGS Best Cleaners Award this year. They have demonstrated pride and commitment in their work, by consistently keeping the area under their charge clean and hygienic. These awards – the highest number to be awarded this year since the CGS Awards were started in 2003 - also underscores the important contribution of our cleaners, as frontline workers in the nation’s fight against COVID-19.

There are four sub-categories for the Best Cleaners Award:

- Hawker Centres
- HDB Estates
- Public Waste Collectors
- Public Cleanliness

Best District	North West District	<p>North West Community Development Council (CDC) has cultivated a robust green culture within the District and will continue to encourage greater environmental ownership by inspiring more residents to embrace Green Living. Their programmes engage residents of all ages, from pre-schoolers to families, to increase environmental awareness and knowledge within the community.</p> <p>Key initiatives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Budding Greenies @ North West</b> – aims to educate pre-schoolers on environmental conservation through experiential learning which comprises a physical green learning corner and an activity book, ‘Go Green with Betty the Butterfly’</li> <li>• <b>North West Sustainability Forum</b> – targets youths and the community at large. A series of forums were organised to exchange ideas and network with like-minded individuals, learn from green changemakers/field experts, gain insights into the green sector and kickstart Ground-Up Initiatives with the North West GIRAFFE Fund.</li> <li>• <b>Green Homes @ North West</b> - rewards families with up to \$300 in grocery vouchers for adopting eco-friendly practices such as purchasing energy efficient appliances, practising energy saving measures at home.</li> </ul>

<p>Best Constituency (National /South West District)</p> <p>&amp;</p> <p>Most Improved Constituency (National)</p>	<p>Hong Kah North</p>	<p>The annual Hong Kah North Environment Day has been a flagship programme of Hong Kah North CCC since 2002. It aims to encourage residents to adopt environmentally friendly practices. The CCC organised the 19<sup>th</sup> instalment of Hong Kah North Environment Day on 15 November 2020. Last year, Hong Kah North Environment Day kicked-off with a three-month campaign, 'Hong Kah North Go Green Movement', which included these key programmes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The first-ever <b>digital recycling competition</b> to motivate residents to recycle regularly by recording their recycling efforts using the 'STEP UP Sustainability App', which is developed by the Public Waste Collector, ALBA W&amp;H Smart City Pte Ltd.</li> <li>• A three-day <b>Green Job Fair</b> that promotes career opportunities in Environmental Services for residents who are interested in the sector and whose jobs have been affected by the economic slowdown caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.</li> <li>• A series of <b>upcycling workshops</b> that cover repurposing old T-Shirts, turning fruit skin into detergent, and cooking using leftover ingredients.</li> <li>• A <b>dialogue</b>, 'Towards Sustainable Living in Hong Kah North', was conducted on Facebook Live to reach out to more residents in the community</li> </ul> <p>The 'Go Green Movement' attracted more than 30,000 participants and viewers both physically and digitally over 3 months. It has also enhanced the residents' knowledge and adoption of green and sustainable living in Hong Kah North.</p> <p>Since then, the CCC has continued to organise online campaigns and competitions to encourage recycling and usage of reusable bags. A series of talks about the Singapore Green Plan and climate change were also conducted.</p> <p>Hong Kah North aims to create an eco-friendly and sustainable community and inspire residents to fight climate change.</p>
<p>Best Constituency Merit (National)</p> <p>&amp;</p> <p>Best Constituency (Central Singapore District)</p>	<p>Yio Chu Kang</p>	<p>The Grassroots Leaders, Volunteers and YIO Clean &amp; Green Ambassadors have dedicated themselves to encourage residents to take greater ownership of the environment through various programmes. Despite the COVID-19 pandemic, these programmes have reached out to more than 6,000 residents.</p> <p>Key initiatives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Origami Food Scrap Box</b> – part of NEA's Clean Table Campaign that promotes ownership of the cleanliness of hawker centres. This initiative involves placing origami boxes at hawker centres to make it easy for residents to dispose their waste and clean their table after eating. This programme started in December 2020, prior to the official launch of NEA's Clean Table</li> </ul>

		Campaign in February 2021. Aside from the origami boxes, grassroots leaders conducted bi-weekly outreach programmes at the Hawker Centre at Blk 628 Ang Mo Kio Ave 4.
Best Constituency Merit (National) & Best Constituency (North West District)	Nee Soon East	Key Initiatives: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Let's Kayak and Clean Up Khatib Bongsu Together</b> - started in January 2021 and is spearheaded by Adviser, Mr. Louis Ng. It aims to raise awareness that improper disposal of trash pollutes the environment at Khatib Bongsu Nature Park and motivate residents to clean-up the mangrove. Residents are also encouraged to provide suggestions that will improve Khatib Bongsu Nature Park. As a result of this programme, approximately 1,000kg of Marine Debris have been cleared from Khatib Bongsu Nature Park and Seletar Island.</li> <li>• <b>Eco Chinese New Year Decoration Display</b> - organised by Yishun Green Walk Residents' Network (RN). Together with a group of residents, they used recycled materials to decorate the precinct for Chinese New Year, which created a festive mood while reducing waste.</li> </ul>
Best Constituency Merit (National) & Most Improved Constituency (Central Singapore District)	Moulmein-Cairnhill	Key initiatives: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Moulmein-Cairnhill Go Green Hackathon 2021</b> - aimed to attract youthful and responsible minds to create sustainable and innovative solutions that will create a greener, more environmentally conscious Singapore. The hackathon was publicised extensively on social media and received a diverse group of participants. These participants presented ideas that address issues such as food waste and e-waste disposal.</li> <li>• <b>Do the Mozzie Wipeout &amp; Keep MoCa Clean initiatives</b> - engaged residents and GRLs on checking and preventing potential mosquito breeding sites. The Taskforce members also disseminated campaign information and relevant articles to NCs, RCs and residents via social media platforms.</li> </ul>
Best Constituency Merit (National)	Potong Pasir	Potong Pasir Grassroots Organisations is committed to collaborating with community partners to implement programmes that are aligned with the Clean and Green Awards objectives. To support the Clean and Green Singapore initiative, Potong Pasir organised programmes from April 2020 to 31 March 2021.  Key initiatives: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>'Do the Mozzie Wipeout'</b> - a programme launched during the dengue outbreak that promotes dengue awareness and prevention.</li> <li>• <b>Cash for Trash</b> - a programme organised by 4 RCs and the Residents' Network that supports Zero Waste Initiatives by promoting 3Rs (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle). Residents were incentivised to recycle their waste instead of discarding them.</li> <li>• <b>Grassroots Social Distancing Ambassadors (SDAs) Patrols</b> - Potong Pasir Grassroots leaders volunteered as SDAs and conducted weekly patrols to educate residents about the SMM guidelines, and ensure residents adhere to these guidelines.</li> </ul>

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Love Potong Pasir, Recycle, Refurbish, Reuse</b> - a programme jointly organised by Potong Pasir CCC, Calvary Community Care and Protorex Limited Partnership to refurbish donated bicycles and gift these restored bicycles to residents in need.</li> </ul>
<p>Best Constituency Merit (National)</p> <p>&amp;</p> <p>Most Improved Constituency (North West District)</p>	Bukit Timah	<p>Bukit Timah rolled out various flagship programmes to support the Clean and Green Singapore Initiative.</p> <p>Key initiatives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>The Upcycled Décor transformation of Bukit Timah Truss Bridge</b> - a two-step process involving 30 grassroots leaders and 70 residents. First, residents and volunteers picked up litter around their neighbourhood through the BIN-IT @ Bukit Timah initiative. The litter (e.g. used plastic bags, bottles and straws) was then upcycled and transformed into lanterns and flowers which were used to decorate the Bukit Timah Truss Bridge. This initiative brought festive cheer to the residents in the area. More importantly, this initiative motivated residents to take ownership of their estate and keep it clean.</li> <li>• <b>Dengue Prevention</b> - Bukit Timah had large dengue clusters in the private estates earlier on. The division supported NEA in the drone inspection of roof gutters in the estates. Grassroots leaders and volunteers also engaged approximately 3,000 households through an outreach campaign. All these efforts contributed towards eradicating dengue clusters in the estates.</li> <li>• <b>PAWsitive Norms Campaign</b> - an initiative that promotes responsible dog-walking. This initiative increased neighbourliness and reduced complaints and conflicts relating to dog poo.</li> </ul>
Best Constituency Commendation (National)	Marymount	<p>The Marymount Grassroots Organisations launched the Marymount Green Plan in 2021 to engender stronger ownership of clean and sustainable living in the community.</p> <p>Based on the interests of the residents in Marymount, the GROs initiated several projects under the Marymount Green Plan. These included developing community gardens, planting more trees, installing paper and e-waste recycling machines, and conducting workshops on upcycling and waste reduction.</p> <p>Key initiatives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>One Earth, Save it! @ Marymount</b> – consists of virtual workshops, virtual educational talks, and physical activities such as Cash for Trash. These activities increased awareness of climate change and encouraged residents to reuse, reduce and recycle.</li> <li>• <b>Clean Hands Project @ Marymount</b> – to encourage personal hygiene during the COVID-19 pandemic, volunteers topped-up hand sanitiser bottles that were installed in HDB lifts. Residents could easily use these hand sanitisers and keep the community safe.</li> </ul>

Best Constituency Commendation (National)	Nee Soon Central	<p>Launched in 2015, Nee Soon Central's recycling programme aims to encourage recycling among residents, reduce the contamination of recyclables, and create opportunities for residents to bond at the recycling points.</p> <p>This programme was created in partnership with North West CDC, Tzu Chi Foundation, National Environment Agency (NEA) and RCs.</p> <p>Since the programme's launch, the division has built a community of committed residents. More residents are sorting their recyclables and learning how to prepare recyclable items from volunteers. The programme also inculcated Environmental Ownership as seen by the volunteers' commitment. Close Community Partnership and Outreach has also been achieved between NEA, the community and programme partner, Tzu Chi Foundation.</p>
Best Constituency Commendation (National) & Best Constituency (South East District)	Braddell Heights	<p>Braddell Heights Division coordinates its green efforts through the Climate Action Taskforce (CAT), which engages residents, partners community networks, and works with private companies to foster community ownership of environmental initiatives.</p> <p>CAT's initiatives include organising book and e-waste recycling drives, increasing the use of reusable masks and lunch boxes, improving public health through education on good hygiene, and gardening activities.</p> <p>The most recent project includes working with Panasonic to develop a hydroponics system powered by AI, which allows residents to grow food at home easily. Produce from this project will be donated to low-income residents in the community.</p>
Best Constituency Commendation (National)	Sembawang West	<p>Sembawang West Zone G partnered with Sembcorp, NEA and RCs in the North West District to organise and manage a recycling drive, 'EziCash For Trash'. This programme was launched in December 2020 and aims to encourage residents in the district to recycle and create opportunities for residents to bond at the various recycling points. The EziCash incentive was successful in increasing the volume of recyclables collected. Sembcorp and the grassroots volunteers regularly engaged volunteers and provided them with training opportunities, therefore promoting strong Environmental Ownership.</p>
Best Constituency Commendation (National)	Nee Soon South	<p>Through Education, Campaigning and Enforcement, Nee Soon South seeks to inspire residents, old and young, to take ownership of their neighbourhood's cleanliness by adopting good habits. The 3 habits include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. WALK THE TALK: lead by example by not littering</li> <li>2. STOP THE BUG: go up to the litterbug and tell him/her to pick up their litter</li> <li>3. PICK IT UP: pick-up litter when I see it and bin it</li> </ol>

		<p>Nee Soon South also creates environmental awareness and protects the environment through conscious actions such as reducing wastage, using reusable bags, learning to reduce, and saying 'No' to plastic bags. They also aim to change other habits including the use of plastic straws, and other single-used plastic items.</p> <p>Residents are also encouraged to recycle and bond with other residents at the various recycling points throughout the town. Over time, Nee Soon South hopes to build a community of residents who are committed to sorting their recyclables, recycling regularly, and learning from volunteers.</p>
Best Constituency Commendation (National)	Woodlands	<p>Key initiatives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Woodlands Book Donation Drive</b> – started in 2015, the book donation drive encourages residents to donate their pre-loved books to low-income families instead of discarding them. In 2019, more than 10,000 books were donated to 1,500 families. In 2021, more than 5,000 books were collected and redistributed despite the COVID-19 pandemic</li> <li>• <b>Elimination of plastic water bottles</b> – Woodlands GROs eliminated the use of plastic water bottles at grassroots events, activities, and meetings. Water dispensers were installed, and residents were encouraged to bring reusable water bottles to these events instead. Woodlands GROs also distributed 12,000 reusable water bottles to households located within the 7 Woodlands Residents' Networks during National Day 2020</li> </ul>
Best Constituency Commendation (National)	Toa Payoh East	<p>Toa Payoh East Zone 6 RC committee members and volunteers have organised a monthly recycling programme since 2014. Aside from collecting as many recyclable items as possible, this programme also aims to emphasise the importance of recycling.</p> <p>Through this programme, residents have learned to identify recyclable items and made an effort to recycle these items. Efforts to sustain the programme are commendable and the RC members aim to reach out to more residents beyond Toa Payoh East.</p>
Best Constituency Commendation (National) & Best Constituency (North East District)	Tampines Changkat	<p>Amidst the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, Singapore also experienced one of the largest dengue outbreaks in history. Understanding the dangers of dengue and importance of dengue prevention, Tampines Changkat grassroots volunteers worked with NEA to promptly disseminate information about the dengue clusters and educate residents about the measures they can take to protect themselves from dengue.</p> <p>As physical community events were not allowed due to the COVID-19 restrictions, grassroots volunteers used online platforms such as social media and telecommunication channels to communicate with residents. When the restrictions were eased, grassroots volunteers also conducted house visits to distribute dengue prevention flyers and insect repellents.</p>



		In November 2020, there were two adjacent red alert dengue clusters in Tampines Changkat. A virtual sharing was conducted to brief volunteers on the dengue situation. Thereafter, house visits were conducted within these clusters to share dengue prevention tips with residents. The fight against dengue is a continuous one. By encouraging the community to do the Mozzie Wipeout together, Tampines Changkat grassroots volunteers hope to keep the dengue clusters and cases under control.
