The 80-hectare Coney Island Park houses a wide variety of habitats, including coastal forests, grasslands, mangroves and Casuarina woodlands. It is home to a wide variety of fauna and flora, some of which are critically endangered. Come follow our volunteer guide to find out more and learn more about the interesting history of the island.
