





CHECK AND PROTECT OUR HOMES.

Dengue cases have been on the rise recently. To protect our loved ones, it is important to prevent mosquito breeding in our homes and remove all stagnant water. Here's a checklist to use:

Areas to Check	Actions to Take	Done
 <p>Plants (e.g. flowerpot plate, plant axils, hardened soil)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flip the flowerpot plate • Clear the axils • Loosen the hardened soil 	<input type="checkbox"/>
 <p>Domestic and ornamental containers (e.g. vase, fountain, pail, toilet brush/toothbrush holder, kitchen dish rack/drying tray)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Turn pail over and wipe rims dry • Remove excess water by tipping vase/brush holders • Change water in the fountain and scrub the surfaces regularly • Wipe dry the kitchen dish rack/drying tray 	<input type="checkbox"/>
 <p>Bamboo pole holder</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cap the bamboo pole holder 	<input type="checkbox"/>
 <p>Roof gutter and drains within compounds</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Treat potential breeding habitats such as roof gutter and drains with Bti insecticide 	<input type="checkbox"/>

Here are two additional steps to keep you and your loved ones safe:



1. Spray insecticide in dark corners around the house



2. Apply insect repellent and wear covered clothes
