- (a) Sharps
- (b) Cultures
- (c) Pathological organs
- (d) Others – All wastes contaminated by body fluid such as blood, urine and faeces from patients with the following diseases:

- (i) High risk (individual)

Level III, eg;

- Rabies
- Hepatitis B (high titre)
- AIDS
- Plague
- Anthrax
- Enteric fever

- (ii) High risk (community)

Level IV eg.

- Lassa
- Margurg
- Ebola
- Smallpox
- Korean haemorrhagic fever
