Dear Sir/Mdm,

EXPORT OF METHYL BROMIDE (MeBr)

As you are already aware, Singapore has been a Party to the Montreal and Copenhagen Amendment to the Montreal Protocol since 2000. Whilst the Copenhagen Amendment places control measures on consumption and production of methyl bromide for non-QPS uses, the Montreal Amendment prohibits trade of Methyl Bromide with non-Parties to the Copenhagen Amendment.

2 We would like to remind all licence holders of Methyl Bromide to observe the obligations placed upon Singapore as a Party and ensure that checks are in place to prevent Methyl Bromide from being exported to countries that have not signed the Copenhagen Amendment.
