SINGAPORE ACCEDES TO THE BEIJING AMMENDMENT TO THE MONTREAL PROTOCOL ON SUBSTANCES THAT DEplete THE OZONE LAYER

Singapore deposited its instrument of accession to the Beijing Amendment with the Secretary-General of the United Nations in New York on **10 Jan 2007**. The Amendment will enter into force for Singapore on the 90th day after the date of deposition of the instrument. With the accession to the Beijing Amendment, Singapore is now a party to the Montreal Protocol and all its Amendment. (The London Amendment, Copenhagen Amendment, and the Montreal Amendment.)

2 As a Party to the Beijing Amendment, Singapore is obliged to ban trade on HCFCs with non-Parties to the Copenhagen Amendment and Beijing Amendment from 1 Jan 2016.
