

Do your cleaners fulfil the Enhanced Training Requirement (ETR)?

Class 1 Licence - At Least 3 Modules

1 Workplace Safety and Health (WSH) Module  **2** Core Modules

Class 2 & 3 Licence - At Least 2 Modules

1 Workplace Safety and Health (WSH) Module  **1** Core Module

- ✓ **All cleaners** (residents and foreigners; casual, temporary, part-timers and full-timers) must be trained within 3 months from employment.
- ✓ Cleaners must attend the applicable training modules based on their PWM job titles.
- ✓ Cleaning businesses must monitor and maintain records of the trainings attained by their cleaners.

Penalties for ETR Non-compliance

- Maximum financial penalty of \$5,000, and Cleaning Business Licence may be suspended or revoked.
- You will not be able to renew your cleaning business licence.
- NEA carries out random audits to check on compliance to licensing conditions (including ETR).

Career and Skills Passport (CSP) platform

What is CSP?	A digital platform where employees store verified training records and qualifications from government sources into one shareable profile, ensuring authenticity for hiring and compliance purposes.
How does direct employee-sharing work?	Employees can create shareable links to send their verified credentials directly to employers via WhatsApp or email.
Who controls the data?	Employees maintain full control over what information to share, can set profiles to public/private, and can update or regenerate sharing links anytime.
How to access?	Employees can access CSP through MySkillsFuture website using Singpass login, with comprehensive guides and tutorial videos available for support.
