The waste collection timing cannot be changed to suit every development's preferred timing. The appointed PWC shall inform the MCST of the collection arrangements nearer to the commencement of services.
- 9. If there are non-domestic premises carrying on businesses in the private apartment / condominium development, the PWC is required to provide separate standard wheeled bins to these premises. However, do note the refuse collection fee will be differentiated by refuse output levels and will not be the same as the domestic fee. The PWC will notify these non-domestic premises of the fees nearer to the commencement of services.
